School Board Nominations

As part of the cyclic process of a School Board, places become available. At this point in time, Mullaloo Beach Primary School, School Board is calling for ONE parent and ONE staff member to fill the positions on the Board at Mullaloo Beach Primary School. The current School Board consists of 5 parents, 4 staff members, 2 community members, and the Principal as ex-officio.

Tenure of Positions available:

1 (one) parent position – period of three (3) years, finishing year end 2019.

1 (one) staff position – period of three (3) years, finishing year end 2019.

If interested, please complete the nomination form and return it to the school office by Friday 25th November 2016.

What is a school board and what does it do?

All Government schools in Western Australia have a School Board. They are legally constituted bodies that are given powers to set the key directions (governance) of a school within centrally provided guidelines. Parents on a school board provide important viewpoints and have valuable skills that can help shape the direction of the school.

Do I need special experience to be on school board?

No. What you do need is an interest in your child's school and the desire to work in partnership with others to help shape the school's future.

Induction

There will be an induction for new members prior to the first meeting with the Chair and Principal. Further training is available upon request. Ongoing support is provided throughout the tenure as members become aware with the governance role.

Once the nomination form is completed, return it to the school administration within the time stated on the notice of election. You will receive a Nomination Form Receipt.

If there are more nominations received than there are vacancies on the School Board, a ballot will be conducted during the weeks after the call for nominations has closed.

Frequency & Time of Meetings

Meetings are held up to twice per term of each school term commencing 6.00pm and last for approx. one hour.
