

PRE-PRIMARY – YEAR 4
SWIMMING LESSONS 2025



Dear Parents and Carers,

Swimming lessons for year Pre-Primary to Year 4 students will be held at Craigie Leisure Centre during week 7 and 8 of this term.

LESSONS: Monday 9 June to Friday 20 June 2025.
TIMES: Sessions will be at 9:20am, 10:05am and 10:55am and 11.40am each day (not including departure and return times).
COST: \$58.50 per student for entry and transport costs.

Parents with more than one child attending lessons, **please fill out one form for each child**. Students are to wear their full school uniform to school and will change into their bathers before departure. **Students will change at school into their bathers, over shirt or dressing gown, towel and thongs and they will travel on the bus to the pool in this attire. Following the swimming lesson, students will return to school where they will change back into their uniform. This provides a safe and exclusive changing area.**

Students will need the following items:

- Bathers /board shorts, goggles (optional) and a towel
- a plastic bag for wet bathers and towel
- all clothing labelled clearly
- medication – asthma inhalers, EpiPen etc.

Students with long hair should ensure it is tied up or secured back before arriving at lessons. It is also recommended that all jewellery be left at home for safety reasons.

Please ensure you complete the attached Interim Swimming Enrolment Form and payment, return it to the front office by Wednesday 28 May 2025.

Student participation is conditional on payment and permission forms being received by the school prior to the activity. Please contact the school should you require a payment arrangement.
